

Campground Extra Guest & Visitor Policy

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This policy is presented to the registered guest at check-in and again as a hand-out they take with them. Visitor fees are not punishment. They cover the real per-person cost of bathhouse, pool, road wear, and insurance load.

1. Site Capacity (Registered Persons)

Each site is reserved for the registered guest and the persons listed on the registration card. The standard site capacity is two adults plus dependent children under 18, with a hard maximum of six total occupants per site.

2. Daytime Visitor Fees (in by 8 PM, out by 10 PM)

Daytime visitors are welcome by prior arrangement at the office. All daytime visitors register at the front desk on arrival, receive a dated visitor pass for the dashboard, and pay the per-person fee below.

3. Overnight Guests Beyond Site Capacity

Persons added to the site after registration who stay overnight are billed at the per-person nightly rate below. Sleeping in a vehicle in the parking area is not permitted without prior office approval.

4. Enforcement (read carefully)

The registered guest is responsible for the conduct of every person on or visiting the site. Unregistered overnight visitors discovered on site are billed retroactively at double the standard add-on rate per night, billed to the payment method on file.

Sites consistently exceeding capacity may be relocated to a larger site (at the higher rate) or asked to leave under the standard park rules. Repeated unregistered-visitor incidents are grounds for non-renewal of long-term stays.

5. How the Park Tracks Site Occupancy

The park does this through normal operations, not surveillance. Front desk records, license plate logs at the gate, ranger walk-throughs, neighbor reports, and pool/bathhouse key fob use are the typical methods. The park does not monitor inside RVs or cabins.

6. Guest Acknowledgement
