

Campground Pool & Hot Tub Policy with Liability Waiver

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One signed copy per family stays in the office. Post the rule list on the pool deck and at every entry gate. Most state codes require posted rules; signing them is what gives your insurance carrier the waiver they ask for at claim time.

2. Pool Rules — Initial Each Line

- 01 Swim at your own risk. No lifeguard on duty.** The park does not provide lifeguards. Adults are responsible for supervising children at all times.
- 02 Children under 14 must have an adult present at the pool.** Adult means a person 18 or older from the registered family. No drop-offs.
- 03 Adult-to-child ratio of 1 to 4 maximum in the water.** Two adults if more than four children under 14 are in the pool simultaneously.
- 04 No glass containers anywhere on the pool deck.** Broken glass in a pool requires a full drain and refill. Violators are billed for the refill.
- 05 No diving, no running, no horseplay.** Pool depth is marked. Pool is not rated for diving. Running on a wet deck causes 80 percent of pool-area falls.
- 06 Swim attire only.** Cutoffs, jeans, and street clothes are not permitted. Loose fabric clogs filters.
- 07 No food or drink in the water.** Eating and drinking permitted at the deck tables only.
- 08 Showers required before entering.** A 60-second shower before entering reduces chemical demand and bather load.
- 09 No pets. No service animals in the water.** ADA service animals are permitted on the deck only, not in the water.
- 10 Pool closes at posted hours.** Last entry 30 minutes before close. Park staff clears the pool at close.

3. Hot Tub Rules — Initial Each Line

- 01 Hot tub maximum capacity is the posted number.** Capacity is set by water displacement and circulation. Going over is a code violation, not just a comfort one.

- 02 No children under 5 in the hot tub at any time.** Children under 5 cannot regulate body temperature in 102+ degree water.

- 03 Children 5 to 14 require an adult in the water.** Maximum 15-minute session for children under 14.

- 04 15-minute maximum session for adults.** Take a 30-minute cool-down between sessions. Multiple back-to-back sessions cause heat exhaustion.

- 05 No alcohol in or near the hot tub.** Alcohol plus hot water is the single most common cause of pool-area medical incidents.

- 06 Pregnant women, persons with heart conditions or high blood pressure should not use the hot tub without a physician's clearance.** Posted at the hot tub. State code requires this disclosure.

- 07 Shower before and after.** Before for chemistry. After to rinse off oils and residue.

- 08 No food or drink in or directly adjacent to the hot tub.** Spills shift pH and contaminate the small water volume quickly.

4. Water Chemistry and Inspection

Pool and hot tub water is tested by trained park staff at least three times per day during operating hours, with results logged on the pool deck. The park maintains chemical readings within state code at all times the pools are open. Guests may ask to see the current day's chemistry log at any time.

5. Assumption of Risk and Release

The adult signing this document acknowledges, on behalf of every family member listed in Section 1, that swimming pools and hot tubs carry inherent risks including drowning, slipping, head and spinal injuries from contact with walls or floors, heat exhaustion, chemical exposure, and electrical hazard. The undersigned assumes all such risks for every listed family member.

The undersigned releases the park, its owners, employees, and agents from any claim arising from pool or hot tub use, except for damages caused by the park's gross negligence or willful misconduct. The undersigned authorizes the park to seek emergency medical assistance for any listed family member who appears to require it.

6. Surveillance Notice

The pool area is monitored by recorded video for guest safety and incident review. Recordings are retained for 30 days. By signing this document, the adult acknowledges this surveillance on behalf of every listed family member.
